### Places to see in the area



#### Blaník Mountain

According to the famous legend, the Blaník Knights live in the mountain. You cannot go inside it, but you can climb to the top and visit the outlook tower. You can make your visit more enjoyable by following the interesting interactive nature trail "A Trip to Blaník Mountain With a Knight".



### Castles and Châteaux

There are many interesting monuments in the area, including Vlašim Château and Park (10 km), Jemniště Château (6 km), Konopiště Château (20 km), Vrchotovy Janovice Château (20 km) and Český Šternberk Castle (35 km).




### **Cycle Routes**

There are three themed cycle routes nearby: "In the Footsteps of the Blaník Knights" (29 km), "Vlašim Avenues" (32 km) and "Romantic Château Parks" (54 km).



### Other Attractions

If you are not interested in historic buildings or cycle routes then the Kršnův dvůr eco-farm (5 km) is certainly worth seeing, as are the goat farm in Hrajovice (15 km), the stud farms in Milovanice (3 km), or the giant seqoia in the château park in Ratměřice (8 km).

### Buchov

The accommodation is part of a group of four periodstyle cottages which make up the hamlet of Buchov. The semi-inhabited settlement lies in the middle of fields and forests of the Blaník Knights Country. Buchov is situated halfway between Benešov and Vlašim, within sight of the legendary Blaník Mountain.



## The idyllically peaceful

countryside environment guarantees a very peaceful break, with absolutely nothing to disturb you.



### Accommodation for six to nine persons in four bedrooms

On the ground floor there is a large living room with fireplace and kitchen area (crockery, gas cooker, fridge and microwave oven); a bedroom with two beds; two WCs and a bathroom with shower. On the first floor there is a gallery, with entry to three bedrooms. The first has a single bed and a double bed; the second has two single beds. The third bedroom contains a double bed.

### Garden

The garden is adjacent to a fishpond (swimming possible in the summer) and has seating, outdoor fireplace and a portable grill.

#### For Children

We have a climbing frame with swings, rope ladder and slide; timber play cottage; and animals: sheep, goat, cats and hens. We also have children's chairs, and a childproof gate at the stairs. A cot and baby carrier are available for hire.

### Shopping and meals

The accommodation is fully equipped with its own cooking facilities. Nespery, a pleasant 1.5-km walk away, has a well-stocked shop which has a counter serving beer. The nearest country restaurant is 5 km away.
